Thank you for your interest in taking the Kansas Concealed carry training course at the Outback Park and Public Range. Here at the Outback, we have an interest in turning out capable, qualified, and safe students. In the interest of these goals, we would like to take a few moments to outline some of the training and give you some information about the demands of the course.

This course consists of classroom training involving safe gun handling, legal issues, and basic firearms discussion. The classroom portion of the class involves a 25 question written test. There is also a range component to the training, involving live fire, gun handling, and a qualifications course.

So that you know ahead of time what will be expected of you, we would like to let you know that you will be given 3 chances to pass the qualification course and then you will be given a short remedial talk. You will then be given 1 more chance to shoot the qualifications course. Failure to qualify in those 4 chances, will result in a failure of the course.

For the qualifications course, you will need to bring 100 rounds. The course is 25 rounds and this will allow for the 4 possible chances, should you need them. You will also need to bring 75 rounds for training and practice, for a total of 175 rounds for the firearm that you bring to class. These rounds will need to be factory rounds. NO HANDLOADS of any sort will be allowed. Rounds will be inspected prior to shooting.

When handling of firearms is required in any class, SAFETY is the number one concern. On this issue, strict observance of safety rules and practices will be enforced. Firearms safety and handling will be the first class given to you when you attend the Kansas Concealed Carry training class at the Outback. When we get to the live fire stage of training and the qualifications course, 3 warnings will be given for safety violations. Because of the inherent danger involved with a mixed group of students handling firearms, repeated violations of the basic safety rules will result in the student failing the course.

Some, but not all of the issues that can get a student removed from the class are as follows:

1. Placing your finger on the trigger when the gun is not on target, sights aligned, and the shooter is ready to fire.
2. Pointing the firearm at yourself or others.
3. Unintentional discharges.

If you find the above issues daunting, don't. You will be told about these and other safety rules over and over before you ever get to the live fire portion of the program. We are here to educate you on proper and safe gun handling and if you are new to shooting or have limited experience with gun handling, don't worry. Together we can make your experience with us safe, fun, and informative. In the end, if you feel that you need some help prior to taking this class, give us a call. We would be glad to answer questions, and if needed, we also offer classes to beginning and inexperienced shooters that can bring up your confidence level.

You need not own a firearm to take the Kansas Concealed Carry training class at the Outback. If you do not own a gun to take the class, just call us and talk to us about renting a firearm for the day. To this end, if your gun fails to pass inspection or if it malfunctions repeatedly, causing the line to cease fire, you will not be allowed to continue with that firearm.

Please let us know if you have any questions or concerns with anything involving this application or the Kansas Concealed Carry training class, and we look forward to seeing you at the Outback Park and Public Range.
